How to Designate Ticket Partners



****BEFORE YOU BEGIN: PLEASE NOTE ****

Ticket Partners receive the following features and benefits:

- Activate and manage his/her own *MyBlueJays* account (linked to the primary Season Ticket Member account).
- Receive their own *MyBlueJays* Card/mobile Card.
- Manage tickets that have been transferred to them by the Primary Season Ticket Member independently.
- Load eCash on their *MyBlueJays* Card/mobile Card for purchases at stadium concessions and Jays Shop locations.
- Receive a 20% discount at *Jays Shop* by using their *MyBlueJays* Card/mobile Card.
- Enter through the exclusive Season Ticket Holder entrance at Gate 6A.
- Earn and redeem points for *MyBlueJays* Reward items.
- Perform advanced ticket exchanges that will count against the Primary Season Ticket Member account's allotment, unless the Primary STM has requested otherwise. All exchanges done by Ticket Partners must be done at the *Rogers Centre* Box Office, and cannot be done online.

The next step after designating Ticket Partners is to Transfer Tickets to them. Please see the "[How to Transfer Tickets to Ticket Partners](#)" tutorial for step by step instructions.

1. Login to your *MyBlueJays* profile.
2. Select, the “**Account**” tab.

3. Select the “**Partner Management**” button.
4. Then, click “**Add New Partner**”.
