2. You will be joined by up to 2 Jays Care volunteers to act as your ambassadors and to help facilitate your JCCC experience. They will be your Jays Care points of contact for the game should you have any questions, needs or concerns.
3. No alcohol is permitted in the Clubhouse
4. The suite hostess is there to help facilitate a comfortable and fun experience for your group. Please ensure she is treated with respect by your children and staff.
5. While at the Rogers Centre, your organization is a guest of Jays Care Foundation. Accordingly, we ask that your behaviour remain appropriate and respectful at all times.
6. We kindly ask that the group remain in the Clubhouse during the game.
7. Please note that we cannot facilitate requests to have visitors come to the suite from another area of the stadium.
