



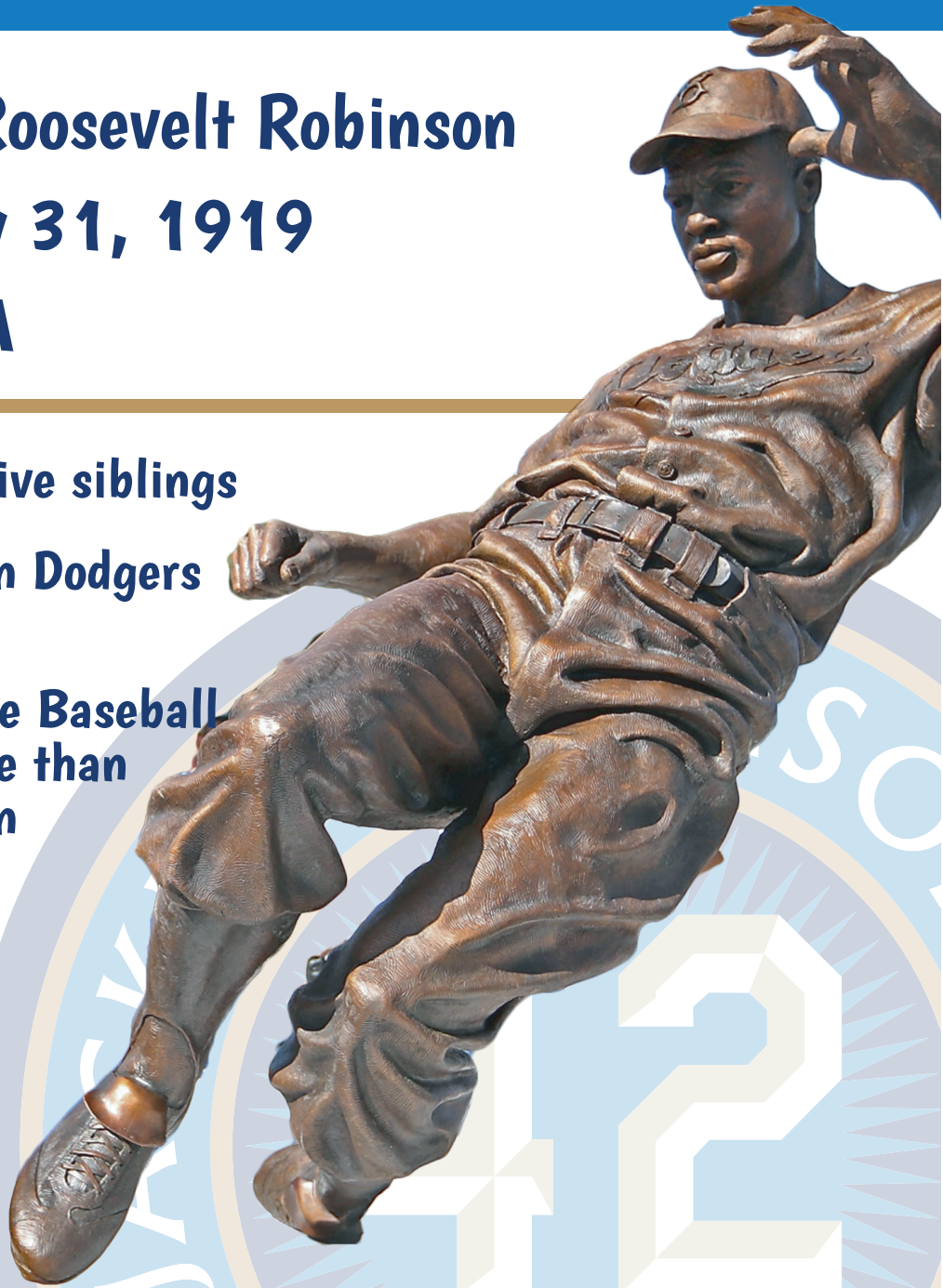
ABOUT JACKIE ROBINSON

Birthday: January 31, 1919

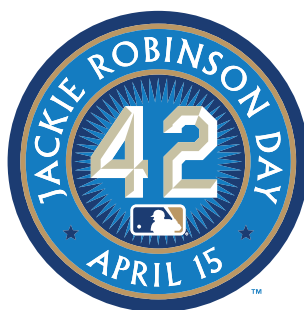
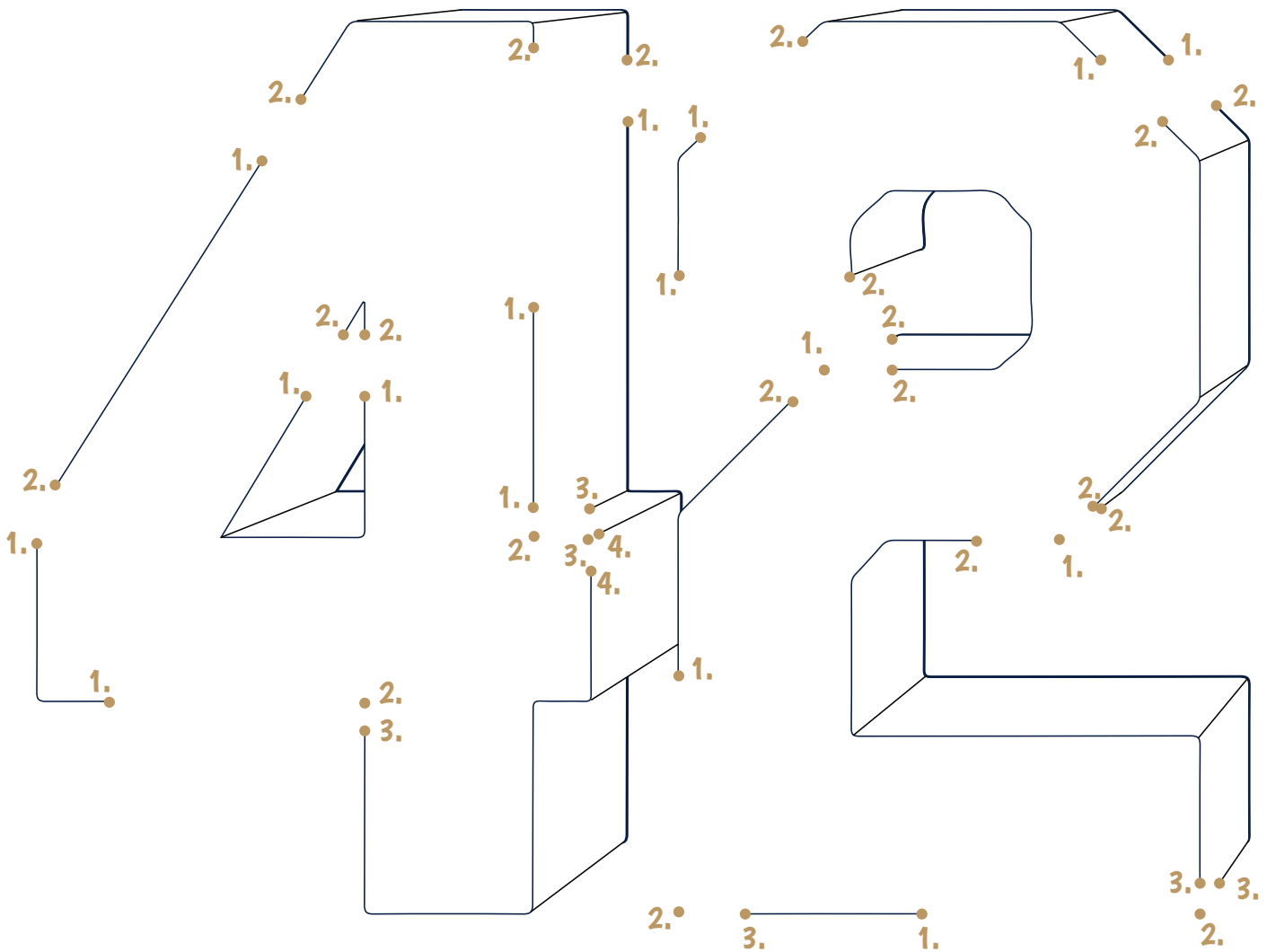
Born in: Cairo, GA

- Youngest child out of five siblings
- Played for the Brooklyn Dodgers from 1947-1956
- Broke the Major League Baseball color barrier after more than 50 years of segregation
- Played a major role in the Civil Rights Movement
- Was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1984
- Played in six World Series, won Rookie of the Year in 1947, and National League MVP in 1949

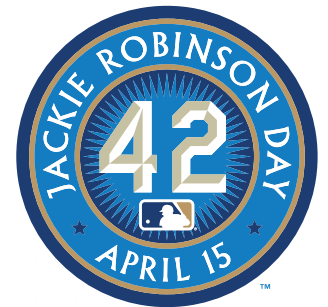
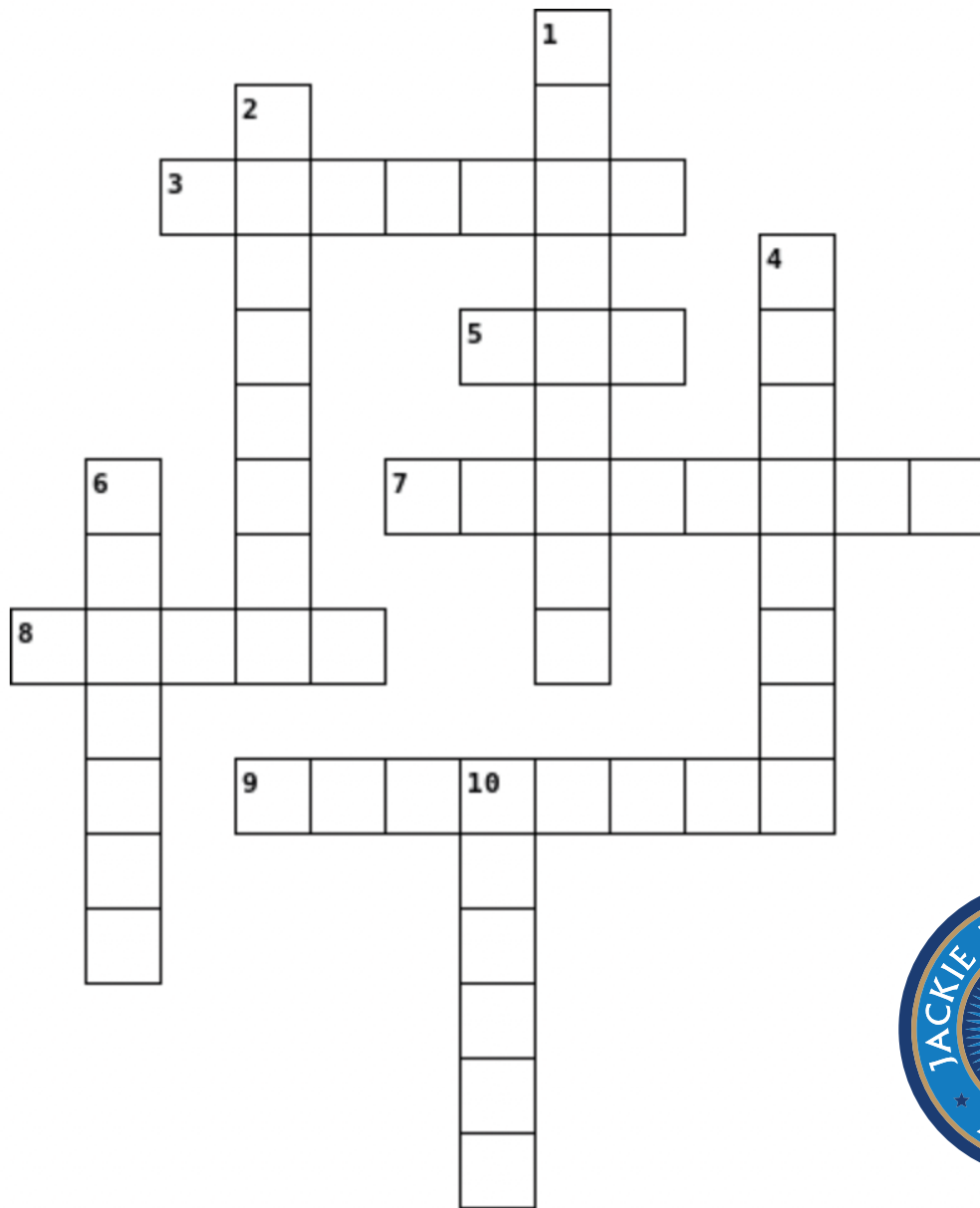
