




Southpaw Paper Bag Puppet

Hey Kids - Make sure you get your parents permission before you make your Southpaw paper bag puppet.



Materials needed:

1. White or brown lunch-sized paper bag. A white bag works best.
2. Markers: green, yellow, blue, black and red. Of course, you can use your own colors.
3. Green pipe cleaners (yellow would work ok also!)
4. Clear tape
5. Scissors

Instructions:

1. Draw two big eyes on "face" of bag. Color the eyes with a blue marker.
2. In "mouth" of the bag draw a tongue with a red marker.
3. Color "face" of the bag with green and yellow markers.
4. On "body" of bag draw the pinstripes and "SOX" on Southpaw's jersey with the black marker.
5. With scissors, cut a 2-inch piece off each pipe cleaner. Wrap each 2-inch section around the end of both pipe cleaners to create Southpaw's "arms and fingers."
6. Tape one "arms and fingers" pipe cleaner in between the fold on each side of the paper bag
7. Enjoy your Southpaw Paper Bag Puppet!
